VAT & Commission



If interested parties wish to know in advance, please enquire with the Auctioneers. Commission at the rate of 5% plus VAT will be payable on all Lots.

• Payment

All items purchased shall be paid for on the day of the sale immediately at the conclusion of the auction. Purchasers wishing to pay by cheque who are unknown to the Auctioneers must produce the relevant reference from their Bank indicating a maximum amount that will be honoured.
