The following Tractors are the tractors around which the floats in the former Spalding flower Parade were built each year and although they were never seen as they were hidden by the decorations, they carry the history of the Flower Parade with them.

As these tractors were hidden by the floats, the mudguards and bonnets were removed along with the three point linkage and the exhausts were altered. Modern parts can easily be obtained to return the tractors to their full working order. All eight of these tractors have been recently running. Please note that there are no Log Books for the tractors shown below.

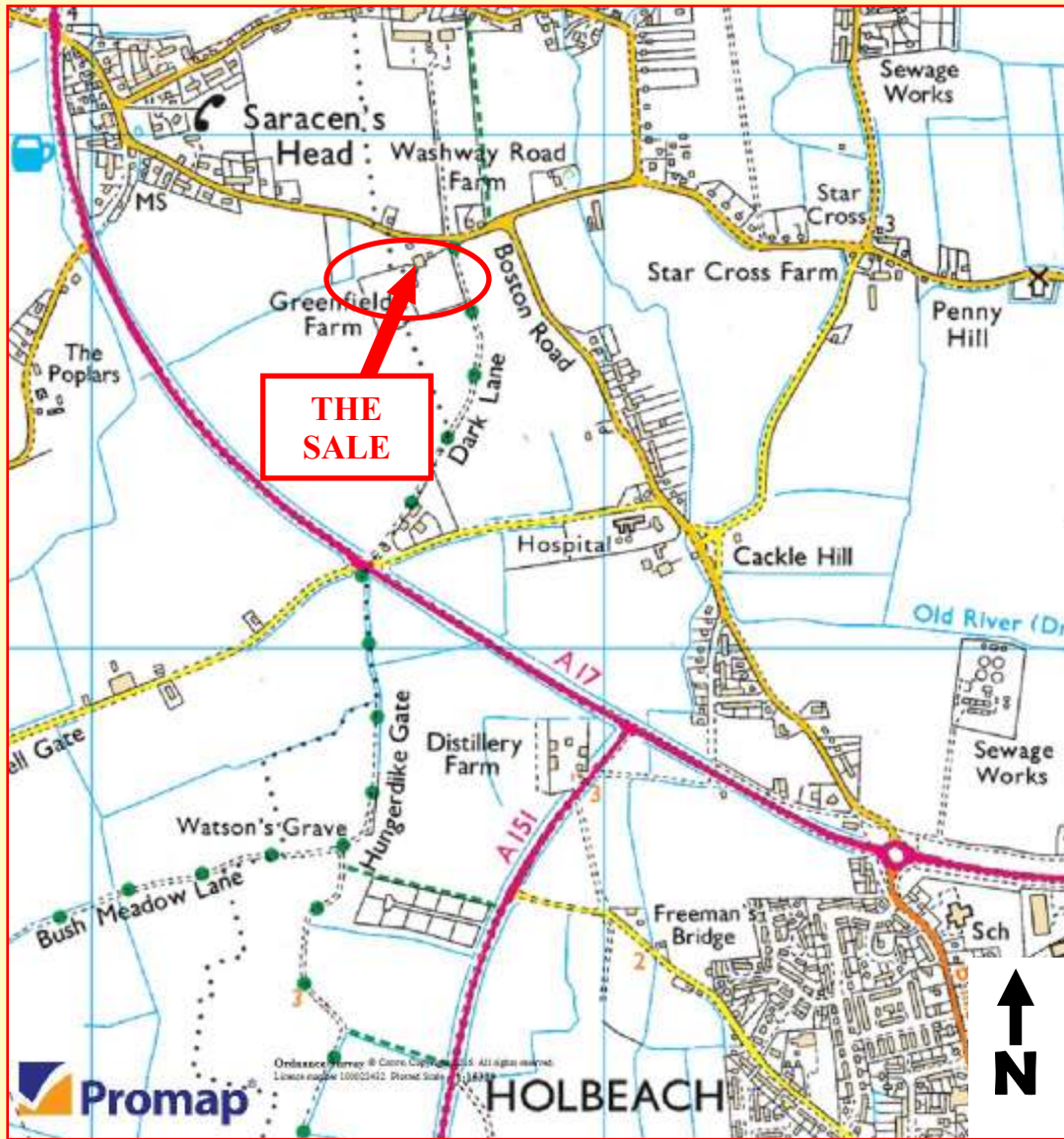

- The Auctioneers act as agents only and do not have personal knowledge as to the accuracy or correctness or otherwise of the description of any Lots offered for sale and give no warranty whatsoever. All warranties, either expresses or implied by sections 13-15 inclusive of the Sale of Goods Act 1979 or at commonlaw are expressly excluded from this Sale.
- At the fall of the hammer each Lot shall be considered as delivered and at the purchaser's risk thereon. All purchasers are required to leave their full name and address at the Auctioneer's Office.
